



## 7 phases of the critical appraisal – with practical tips!

Phase	Topic	Contents	Examples
1	Starting the discussion	<ul><li>Welcome</li><li>Eye contact</li><li>Friendly address</li><li>Ideally one-on-one</li></ul>	<ul> <li>→ " it's nice that we have met to sort it all out. For me, the occasion is"</li> <li>→ " I am glad that we are talking now. I am concerned about the following issue"</li> </ul>
2	Confrontation with criticism	<ul> <li>Wording of the actual criticism</li> <li>Calm, objective, respectful, unambiguous</li> <li>First person perspective</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>→ "I noticed that"</li> <li>→ "I was vexed at the way you"</li> <li>→ I don't agree with the behaviour that"</li> </ul>
3	Statement of the criticised person	<ul> <li>Give time to think</li> <li>Encourage to share their own views</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>→ That's how I see it. And now I would be interested in your opinion"</li> <li>→ "Can you relate to that?"</li> <li>→ "What were your motivations?"</li> </ul>
4	Assessment of the facts	<ul> <li>Find a solution</li> <li>Explore consequences</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>→ How can you do things differently?"</li> <li>→ What other options do you see in this matter?"</li> <li>→ "If things are the way they are now, how do we want to shape our cooperation in the future?"</li> </ul>





5	Make agreements	Formulate specific results	<ul> <li>→ "So we agree that"</li> <li>→ "So we are pursuing your proposal that in future"</li> <li>→ "In similar situations please come to me and"</li> </ul>
6	End of the conversation	<ul> <li>Draw a conclusion</li> <li>Come to a positive wrap-up</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>→ "I experienced the discussion as extremely constructive"</li> <li>→ Have we addressed all the issues?"</li> <li>→ "For me, the solution is satisfactory. How do you feel about it?"</li> </ul>
7	Follow-up appointment	Agree time frame for success review	→ "We should talk about what we discussed again in x weeks, what do you think?"
